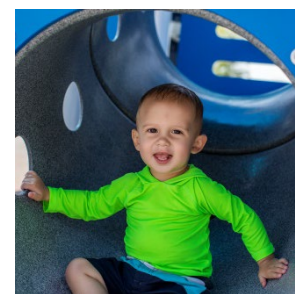

Mansfield Parks & Recreation  
since a 1992 public vote.

The sales tax covers most new projects and development created since the fund was established but does not pay for maintenance of city property, special events, senior programs or parks developed before 1992.

Mansfield Parks & Recreation is managed by the Mansfield Park Facilities Development Corporation (MPDFC), a board of appointed volunteers who oversee the budget. Major projects and initiatives require approval from Mansfield City Council after passing MPFDC.

In addition to planning & maintaining all city parks and running recreation programs out of the Mansfield Activities Center, the department is responsible for:

- Senior Lifestyles classes & daily programs, operating out of the MAC
- Kids Zone summer/school holiday day camp
- Nature Education programs operating out of Oliver Nature Park
- All major city special events, including Rockin 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Hometown Holidays, and all city parades & 5k races
- Landscaping & maintenance work on medians & right-of-ways, city facilities and city-owned property
