Public Notice

The Mansfield Municipal Court is rescheduling all defendants, jurors, and witnesses set for a hearing or trial beginning March 16, 2020. You will receive a written notice from the Court advising you of the new date, and time of your hearing, trial or jury service.

Note: The City of Mansfield Municipal Court continues to operate during regular business hours. Staff is available to assist attorneys and defendants with clerical functions such as filings, answering questions, taking payments, records, setting up payment plans, etc.

Due to the rapidly developing situation regarding Coronavirus (COVID-19), the City of Mansfield Municipal Court, located at 1305 East Broad Street will enact the following changes, effective immediately:

- All hearing beginning March 16, 2020, will be rescheduled to a later date.
- Individuals will be notified by mail.

For those who wish to visit the court in person, be advised that we are practicing social distancing as prescribed by the Center for Disease Control and the Tarrant County Public Health Department.

Although there is currently no vaccine to prevent COVID-19, the best way to prevent infection is to take the following precautions:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
