The City of Mansfield, Texas (the Owner) will accept sealed bids for **WEST BROAD STREET EXTENSION PLANTING AND IRRIGATION** described in general as follows: **Landscape, irrigation and planter construction as shown in the Construction Documents or as outlined in the specifications for West Broad Street Extension Planting and Irrigation.**

Contract Documents, and specifications, may be obtained from Stewart Engineering on Pioneer Parkway in Arlington, TX upon payment of a check in the amount of \$50.00 per set. The check is non-refundable. Cash cannot be accepted. Plans will be available for pick up on **July 15, 2014**. A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on **July 30, 2014 at 2:00 p.m.** in the City of Mansfield Multi-Purpose Room.

A Cashier's Check or an acceptable Bidder's Bond, payable to the City of Mansfield, Texas, in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the largest amount bid must accompany the bid.

A Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in the amount of not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price shall be required, conditioned upon faithful performance of the contract and payment of all persons supplying labor or furnishing materials. These bonds shall be fully executed and accompany the signed contract.

The successful bidder shall also furnish to the Owner a Maintenance Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract covering defects of material and workmanship for one-year following the Owner's approval and final acceptance of the work.

This program is funded through the Tree Mitigation Fund.

In case of ambiguity or lack of clearness in stating prices in the Proposal, the amount shown in words shall govern. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any or all informalities. No bid may be withdrawn until the expiration of forty five days (45) days from the date bids are opened.

Bid Proposal must be submitted on the forms bound within the bidding documents. The right to accept any bid, or to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities is hereby reserved by the Owner.
