

Event Request Guideline

Mansfield Fire Rescue puts a high priority on interacting with the citizens it serves. When schedules permit and when not committed to a fire or medical incident, our crews proudly participate in community events, school visits and station tours. We are unable to support private events such as birthday parties and business openings.

Fire Station Tour information

Station tours last approximately 30 minutes and include viewing the fire engine, firefighting equipment, fire gear, and a short presentation concerning fire safety.

- Tours may be scheduled between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. Monday through Friday.
- Groups should be no larger than 20 persons including children and adults.
- Station tours are not recommended for children under 5 years of age.
- Carpooling is encouraged due to a limited number of parking spaces.
- Please understand your tour may be interrupted. Fire personnel must remain “in-service” during tours and the firefighters may need to respond to emergencies. If this occurs, it will be necessary for the tour to end and your group will need to exit the station. If your tour is interrupted by an emergency call, you will be given the opportunity to reschedule your visit.
- If firefighters are not at the station when your group arrives, they are out on an emergency call. If they do not return within 15 minutes, it will be necessary to reschedule your tour.
- You are welcome to tour a fire station but may not hold party festivities at the facility.

Fire Truck Scheduling

A visit from your local fire station will include viewing the fire engine, firefighting equipment and a short presentation concerning fire safety.

- Fire Engine visits last approximately one hour and may be scheduled between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., Monday through Friday.
- Engine visits are not recommended for children under 5 years of age.
- Please understand your engine visit may be interrupted. Engine companies must remain “in-service” and the firefighters may need to respond to emergencies. If this occurs, it will be necessary for the engine to leave.
- Firefighters enjoy getting out in the community, but will be unable to attend birthday party festivities.
- Other Special Events will be scheduled at the discretion of the Fire Chief.
