



Neighborhood Beautification Program



- WHAT:** The Clean Water Project will provide help in sponsoring neighborhoods and small groups wishing to organize cleanup areas throughout the City. This program will help improve the natural beauty of the City, and help improve the community character by reducing the blight of litter.
- WHO:** Volunteers will make this program a success!! The Mansfield Clean Water Project and Mansfield Stormwater Management Program will organize this important program.
- WHERE:** Any location in the City where volunteers can obtain access and there is a problem. When the area is on private property, the City may assist the group in obtaining access.
- WHEN:** Whenever the group can get together.
- WHY:** Litter is a problem for our local waterways. Not only does it look bad, but some items can also cause problems for aquatic life. Removing these items makes our waterways cleaner and it looks better afterward.
- HOW:** Sheer people power will help make this program a success. The City has prepared a manual to help residents organize and host a cleanup event. The City will also provide some materials, such as garbage bags, latex gloves and flyers. When possible, City staff can be present at the event or give a presentation to the group to better understand why it is important and how it helps.
