

TOWN PARK

500 NORTH MAIN STREET

The land on which this park is located was donated to the Mansfield Park Facilities Development Corporation in 1994. The newest of the city's parks, Town Park opened in summer 2006 and is totally ADA accessible. It serves as a major



trail head to the Walnut Creek Linear Park. A unique feature of the park is the 600-seat

amphitheater for outdoor concerts and events. Among the amenities: two custom playgrounds; a large covered corporate pavilion; three covered picnic areas with tables; two lighted full basketball courts; a sand volleyball court; seven picnic tables with grills; a 12-foot wide concrete trail with connections to Pleasant Ridge Drive, Historic Downtown Mansfield and Katherine Rose Memorial Park; more than a half mile of concrete walking trails; soft surface trails; wildflower nature areas; two horseshoe pits, and restroom facilities.
